Final day of Term Arrangements Wednesday 19 July 2023

The last day of term is Wednesday 19 July 2023. Students will be required to be in the academy as normal by 8.40am. The academy day will **finish at an earlier time of 12.20pm**. Students will be able to purchase their lunch during the break time service including students who have a free school meal where they will be able to collect their lunch. We will notify the school bus service of this earlier finish.

Arrangements for the Start of the New Academy Year

There will be a staggered start to the new academic year to enable us to spend focused time with each year group on their return. Here are the dates when students are required to start in September:

Please can I remind you about the revised timings of the academy day from September. Students are expected to be in the academy by 8.30am and there is a slightly later end to the academy day of 3pm.

Attendance

Please can I take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support in improving whole school attendance and punctuality. The impact upon children's education through lost learning is huge. I urge you to ensure that your child is in the academy on time every day to prevent them from falling behind with their learning.

<u>Uniform</u>

Please see attached reminders of our uniform policy from Mr O'Brien. Please can you ensure your child has their full uniform on return to the academy in September. We are continuing to drive improved standards across the academy and we value your support. This includes replacing ties if your child has lost theirs.
