Lisa is the career adviser from Tameside Careers Service and meets with targeted students across Key Stage 4 every Monday. Brook is Positive Steps Careers advisor and supports students in school every Wednesday and alternative Thursdays.

Tameside Careers Service and Positive Steps provide career guidance interviews to Y10/Y11 pupils and targeted interviews with KS3 students. Pupils are encouraged to;

- Talk through career ideas.
- Supported to manage and plan their future career goals.
- Explore possibilities they may never have considered, raise aspirations and inspired to aim high.
- Information and advice on colleges/sixth forms, courses and higher education.
- Information on how to apply for apprenticeships at 16 and other work -based learning opportunities.
